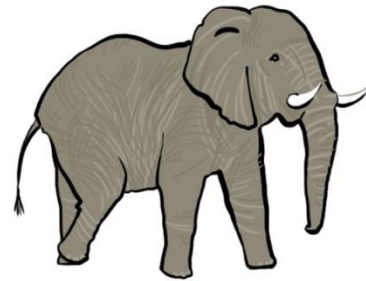
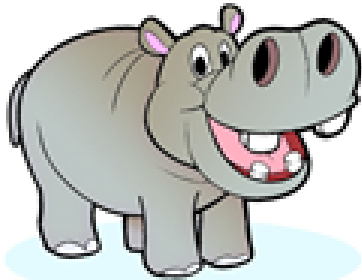

Year 1

- Creative Curriculum
 - Topic based.
 - Topic encompasses Literacy, Science, Art, D&T, Geography and History.
 - Maths and P.E. are stand alone subjects but sometimes linked if relevant.
 - Within the topic there are WOW days, trips, visitors and whole school themes which may link.
 - Topic changes every term.

Lunches

Reading and RWI

- In school, children will complete a reading and tasks every day during RWI. Depending on the group that they are in, they will take home a new reading book regularly (either every 3 or 5 days).
- Parents are encouraged to listen to their child read and check understanding with questions found at the back of the books.
- Books **NEED** to come back or parents will be expected to pay!
- Library time will be weekly. Children will have the opportunity to take home a book. Books need to be returned each week.



R.E.

- Every day the children join in with three prayers – at the beginning and end of the day, and before lunch.
- Every day, the children take part in an assembly or a time of whole class worship.
- The children also have two hours of R.E. a week.

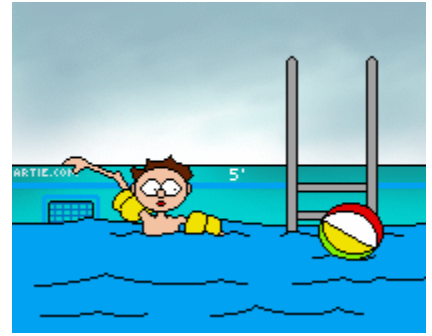


P.E.

- In Year One, P.E. is on Wednesday.
- P.E. kits should be brought in and left at school until the end of half term.
- P.E. kit should include, dark shorts and a white t-shirt with the school logo (these are available from the Office). For outdoor PE, children should have plimsolls or trainers, dark jogging bottoms and a jumper.



Swimming



- Swimming will start in April after the Easter holidays.
- Children will need their swimming costume and a towel.
- All children are expected to swim because it is part of the curriculum.
- A doctor's certificate is the only reason for not participating in swimming.



Home learning

- Homework will start after Christmas and be set every Friday, and should be handed in by the following Wednesday.
- Children need to complete the Maths task online and Topic task in their homework book. The children should record their work in their homework book unless it is practical, when a photograph or the model can be brought in to show.
