Year 2

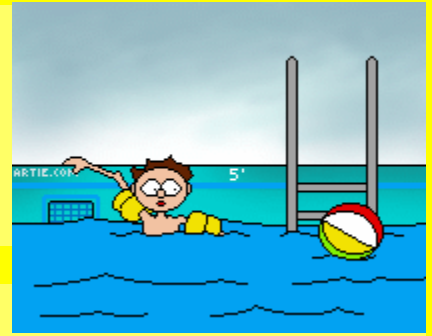
- Topic based curriculum
- Topic encompasses Literacy, Science, Art, D&T, P.E., Geography and History.
- Reading and Writing- Read Write Inc or Literacy and Language
- Maths is a stand alone subject but sometimes linked if relevant.- Maths Mastery.
- Within the topic there are WOW days, trips, visitors and whole school themes which may link.

P.E.



- In Year Two, PE is on Monday.
- PE kits should be brought in and left at school until the end of half term.
- PE kit should include, dark shorts and white t-shirt.
- For outdoor PE, children should have plimsolls or trainers and dark jogging bottoms.

Swimming



- Swimming is also on a Monday.
- Children need swimming costumes and towels.
- All children are expected to swim because it is part of the curriculum.
- A doctor's certificate is the only reason for not participating in swimming.
- You will be informed when swimming will stop.

Reading and RWI

- In school children will complete a reading task every day during RWI. Depending on the group that they are in, they will take home a new reading book regularly.
- Parents are encouraged to listen to their child read and check understanding with questions found at the back of the books.
- Books **NEED** to come back!

Reading Challenge!

Target: 20 books per term!

- Every 10 books read will earn a certificate for both parent and child.
- Library is available 4 lunchtimes and twice after school.
- Reading buddies available every Monday lunchtime.

Homework

- Homework will be set every Friday, and should be handed in by the following Thursday.
- The tasks that the children need to complete will be in their homework book. The children should record their work in their homework book unless it is practical, when a photograph or the model can be brought in to show.
- Weekly spellings

R.E.

- Every day the children join in with three prayers – at the beginning and end of the day, and before lunch.
- Every day, the children take part in an assembly or a time of whole class worship.
- The children also have two hours of RE a week.

SATs

- Children take Government required tests in May.
- Reading, Spelling, Grammar and Maths.

Uniform

- Green Jumpers
 - Tartan kilts and ties
 - Dark trousers and tights
 - Black school shoes
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- Please put your child's name in every item of uniform.

Lunch

- All children will be provided with a school lunch free of charge.
- Children **do not** need to bring in a home packed lunch
