Equipment

- Pencil case: Pens and pencils glue stick, ruler, whiteboard pen.
- Reading book: Pupils can now use the school library and must bring a reading book to class everyday.

- Snacks: At break time they are allowed to have fruit.



P.E.

- For outdoor PE, children should have plimsolls or trainers and black or blue jogging bottoms.



Swimming

- Children need their swimming costume and a towel. They need to bring these in weekly until after half term.
- All children are expected to swim because it is part of the curriculum.
- A doctor's certificate is the only reason for not participating in swimming.

School uniform

- Children should be wearing black school shoes and not trainers.
- Shoes can be changed for trainers at lunch time, if they wish to play sports outside.
- Most uniform orders have now been received in school and will be with you shortly. Uniform queries can be dealt with at the LPS.
