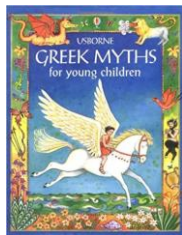

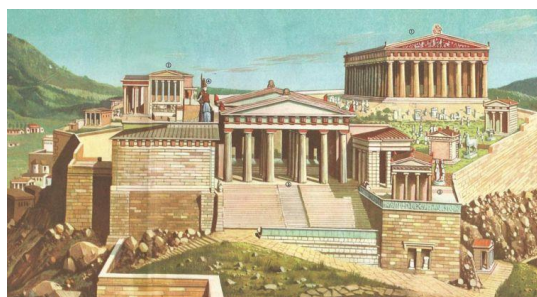


Parent Top Tip
