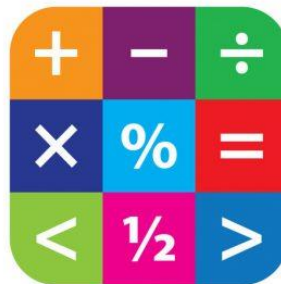


#### Parent Top Tip

- Classify 2-D shapes and reason about regular and irregular polygons.

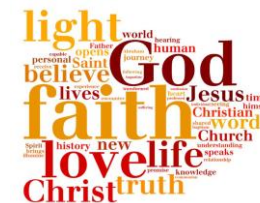


#### Parent Top Tip

- Stewardships

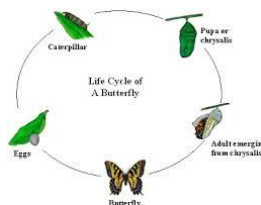


#### Parent Top Tip
