Physical Development

Keeping healthy, food and exercise. Moving creatively with control.



Parent Top Tip

Encourage your child to eat more fruit and vegetables. Go for walks in the park. Help your child learn to put their shoes and socks on.

Maths

Recites numbers one to ten in order.

Begins to represent numbers, using fingers, marks on paper or pictures.

Count objects carefully.

Compares two groups of objects, saying when they have the same number.

Shows an interest in shape and space by playing with shapes or making arrangements with objects.

Parent Top Tip

Count different things at home and in the park e.g. buttons, vegetables, trees, leaves etc.



Expressive Arts and Design

Self-portraits, sings familiar songs and experiment with colours and respond to different textures.

Parent Top Tip

Make patterns in the mud with a stick.
