Creative Curriculum

Discrete subjects

P.E.

- In Year Three P.E. is on Tuesday.
- P.E. kits should be brought in on a Monday and left in school all week.
- P.E. kit should include: black shorts and a white t-shirt with the school logo (these are available from the Office).
- For colder months, children should have plimsolls or trainers and black jogging bottoms.

Swimming

- Children will be swimming every Tuesday up until half term (weather permitting), and again after Easter.
- Children need their swimming costume and a towel.
- All children are expected to swim because it is part of the curriculum.
- A doctor's certificate is the only reason for not participating in swimming.

School uniform

- Children should be wearing black school shoes and not trainers.
- When wearing the winter uniform, ties must be worn.
- In the interest of hygiene and safety, long hair must be tied up.

Homework

- Homework is given on a Friday and must be completed and handed in by Wednesday of the following week.
- Maths and Topic are given each week.
- Spellings will also be given in the next 2 weeks – Spelling Shed.
- Reading should be completed every day for 10 – 15 minutes.
