Learning in KS1:

- Learning starts from 8:30 am.
- It is a topic linked curriculum.
- Topic encompasses English, Geography, History, Art and Design Technology and Science where appropriate.
- Maths is a stand alone subject where all children work in small groups and work with an adult twice a week through a carousel system.
- Children 'floor book' their learning.
- Within the topic there are WOW days, trips, visitors and whole school themes which may link.

Worship

Every day the children join in with three prayers – at the beginning of the day, before lunch and at the end of the day.

Every day, the children take part in an assembly, plus a time of whole class worship.

Children also have two and a half hours of R.E. learning a week which takes place at 9 am.



Homework:

- Whilst we do not set formal homework in KS1, children are expected to read daily at home.
- There are also online learning platforms that they can access – letters with further information will be sent home once the children have accessed them in school.
